

**Grassroots Arts Program - Schedule of County Allotments for Fiscal Year 2015-16**

These figures are based on Grassroots allocation of \$2,453,708 (with the \$150,000 increase from FY2015) according to a formula that assigns 20 percent in equal grants to all counties and 80 percent by population base. The formula uses a state population of 10,154,507 as determined by the 2016 population projection prepared by the State Data Center. Allotments are rounded to the nearest dollar.
