



## Using a free website to size images for AGO - PIXLR.COM


- Download and save your image from your digital camera to a file on your personal computer. You must use an image that has at least one side larger than 1920 pixels. A 4 MB or larger image is ideal.
- Go to <https://pixlr.com/editor/>
- Open the image from your computer.
- Go to *Image > Image Size*. Set the largest side (in this example, the width) and set to 1920, make sure the constrain proportions box is checked.




- In the Layers box to the right, double click the lock icon. It should turn into a check box and now be named Layer 0.




- Go to *Layer > New Layer*. Layer 1 will appear in your Layers box. Click and drag Layer 1 so it is underneath Layer 0.



- Go to *Image > Canvas Size*. Resize so that both width and height are 1920. Click the middle square in the 9 square grid in order to anchor the image in the middle.



- Select the paint bucket from the box of tools to the left. Make sure you have selected black in the color in the large rectangle at the bottom of the tools menu (it is the default, so it is most likely already chosen). Then, take the paint bucket tool and click in the white mask around the image in order to turn it black.



- Under *File*, click *save*. Select JPEG for format. You can select above 80 for quality—as long as the size in the bottom right corner does not exceed 1.8 MB.
